ZECHARIAH - PART II

(Study Material from Berean Study Bible, Tony Evans Bible Commentary, and Thru the Bible Notes)

Zechariah's (LORD remembers) good news of the coming kingdom is expanded to include the good news of the coming King. A future King will destroy Judah's enemies, protect the nation, and bring peace and prosperity. His glorious kingdom will have a champion who will make the house of Judah the preeminent empire on earth.

I. The King is Coming, 9:1 – 14:21

a. The King's First Coming, 9 - 11

- i. The prophetic promise of Zechariah is that there will come a time when the enemies of God's people will be permanently removed.
- ii. Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey days before he was crucified as an atoning substitute for sinners and rose for the dead, Matt 21:1-11.
- iii. Not only will the LORD judge external enemies, but He will also judge enemies among them, 10:3.
- iv. The LORD called Zechariah to stand in as a good shepherd (John 10:11-16), but the people rejected him, Rom 11:25; Ex 21:32; Matt 26:14-16.

b. The King's Second Coming, 12 – 14

- i. Armageddon to be fought, 12:3
- ii. God's enemies to be destroyed, 12:4, 9; 14:2-3, 12-15
- iii. Israel to recognized to Christ, 12:10-14
- iv. Israel to be cleansed, 13:1
- v. Some Jews perish, some saved, 13:8-9
- vi. Jerusalem to be surrounded and taken, 14:2
- vii. Christ appears upon the Mount of Olives, 14:4,8
- viii. Gentiles worship the LORD, 14:16-19

II. Kingdom Applications

- a. Zechariah 9:9. Joy of Anticipation: The call to "rejoice greatly" reminds believers of the joy that comes with the anticipation of Christ's coming. This joy is rooted in the fulfillment of God's promises.
- b. Hope for tomorrow is Faith for today, Titus 2:11-15. Keep the faith
